




1. Welcome –

3. Discussion on Assessment and Accreditation of HEI by NAAC –



The ideas, activities under the citizens to netizens were explained by Dr. Bharti she said that it will be unique best practice by our college if agreed.


The almost every member accepted the idea that the KOC i.e. Know Your Culture' and Citizens to Netizens considered as the unique practices to follow by college for year 2021-22.

1. Welcome –

The IQAC members were welcomed by the secretary of IQAC. It's a welcomed gift to encourage others to achieve greatness. Genuine warmth of welcome took a good moment, good thoughts into better moments, better thoughts and better planning for the Institute.

Student representative presented the welcome song as well as the teacher representative presented Sharada Stavan. The environment for meeting has become very pure and holy.

2. Reading and approval to the minutes of meeting of previous IQAC meeting –

Hon. Rajesh Sir chaired the session with his permission the meeting begin. The minutes of the meeting held on 1st May, 2021 was started to read by the secretary. The minutes were read and asked for any suggestions of changes. Every member present for the meeting nodded his head in 'Yes' and approved the minutes of the previous meeting.

3. Discussion on development of Social platforms for students (DLLE) –

The teacher representative said that NSS is one of the known social platforms. Besides that, there is another social platform known as DLLE – Department of Life Long Learning and Extension. It is under the University of Mumbai. DLLE provides a platform for social work to the students and in return gives ten grace marks as reward of social attachment. There is no limit for enrolment of students in the DLLE. It also provides a cultural platform for students in form of street plays, poster making on social issues as well as social acts. On these notes, as per demand of teachers and students, IQAC allowed the college to register with DLLE.

4. Discussion on upscaling of Library resources –

Library is the best knowledge resource for every HEI – the discussion on this subject is open for meeting. The expert members also participated in the discussion. The expert members appreciated the college library as one of the aesthetic infrastructure with knowledge centric place.

The teacher members and student members also agree with it. They said it is a privilege of the college. Upgradation and upscaling of the library was discussed. The teacher and student members were suggested up scaling the library by – OPAC, NDL, N-List. OPAC is Online Public Access Catalogue. The OPAC is an online bibliography of a library collection that is available to the users.

NDL is National Digital Library. The college should subscribe the membership for NDL. N-List is National Library and Information Services. It opens knowledge internet falls for every knowledge lover student. The meeting took the decision to start with in upscaling at library with OPAC, N-list and NDL.

5. Discussion on Extension activities in HEI –

Hon. Chairperson, Expert members, Teacher representative, non-teaching representatives and student members agreed that the extension activities in HEI should carried out on greater extension. At present, in look down situation, it can be carried out on ONLINE mode. However, on return of offline mode, the momentum should swing in great acceleration. Cultural, sports, NNS, DLLE, social activities, Gender equalities and skill gaining activities must carried out for holistic development of students. The students' representative suggested that there should be 'online' competitions so that the students can give off their psychological barrier, trauma which accumulated due to pandemic situation.

6. Discussion on focus on Research and Innovation –

The teacher members were especially keen on this matter. Teacher members said that Research and Innovation is indispensable part of curriculum and co-curriculum. Teacher members further added that teacher will lead the Research along with students. Teacher also suggested to undergo Research Conferences. It will help to exchange and referent thought



process. The student members also agreed for it and said that they will actively participate in such great activity.

7. Discussion on Research Fund provision for teachers –

On behalf of Management and Governance body, Hon. Rajesh Sir led the discussion. The expert members accepted with every other present members.

Hon. Chairperson said that Teachers means every teacher better to submit the research project. The management will provide the research fund to carry out. 12. Discussion of Library N- List, NDL and OPAC -



1. Welcome –



6. Discussion on Industrial visit of students –


