- To provide right job for the right person in right place.

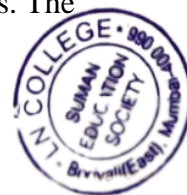
The Context

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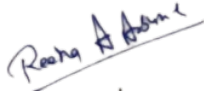
Even though after the COVID-19 situation, the financial aid to needy students continued by the management.
